Non-Resident Tuition Application for Students Entering Grades 4-6

May 2017

Interested Out-of-Town Tuition Applicants:

Enclosed is the application for attendance at MHT. In addition to your completed application, please also include the following:

- Two recommendations to be provided, including one by a current teacher.
- Parent letter to address why you would like your child to attend MHT and your expectations
- Transcript from school/academic record for prior and current year, as applicable.
- Results of any testing (Smarter Balanced, NECAPS, etc.).

After your application is received, it will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee.

In addition to the application process, the applicant's parent or guardian must visit the school, without the applying child in attendance. At a later date, the applying child must visit MHT for a school day.

Our tuition program is available to students who live off-island and wish to apply for attendance at MHT. All applications for non-resident students will be considered on an equal basis. The annual tuition averages to be \$7,900. No scholarship opportunities are available at this time. For families wishing to send a second, third etc. sibling as a tuition-in student, there will be a 35% discount. For example, the first child will be charged at the full tuition-in price of \$7900.00, but every subsequent sibling will receive a 35% discount (i.e. for a discounted rate of \$5135.00) from the total tuition.

Students may be accepted depending on space availability in a class to which the student wishes to enroll, and appropriate educational programs or services available to the student, including physical facilities for educational purposes. Enrollment will be reviewed on a quarterly basis, and students must maintain acceptable grades and behaviors as stated in the student and parent handbook, which is available online at <http://mht.sau50.org>.

Application Process for Students Entering Grades 4-6

Maude H. Trefethen is ready to welcome non-resident tuition students to our student body through an application process. Application forms are found on our website at: <http://mht.sau50.org>. If you have any questions, please contact Maude H. Trefethen School at (603) 436-5416.

1. Application decisions are based on the answers to the following questions:

- Whether space is available based on current enrollment of students (past and present) in the grade level or classroom in which the student desires to be enrolled.
- Whether MHT has appropriate educational programs and services available, including physical facilities, to meet the educational needs of the student?
- Does the student's past academic record match well with MHT expectations and policies?
- Whether the student has demonstrated a history of academic engagement, as measured by the following criteria:
 - Student application for admission
 - Student transcripts and academic records from the past two (2) years
 - Recent testing and assessments
 - Work samples
 - Two letters of reference including one from a teacher
 - Two essays including an essay of at least 100 words stating why they want to attend MHT
 - A day visit by the student
 - An interview with grade level team
 - An interview with the principal

2. Make an appointment for the student and parent(s) to participate in the following:

- A parent interview with the principal and the appropriate grade level teacher.
- A day visit to the school and a meeting with the principal and the appropriate grade level teacher for the interested student.
- With advance notice, an additional visit will be arranged as necessary and as requested.
- It may be necessary for your child to have additional academic assessments completed so that we can better gauge his/her academic needs.

3. Mail application to school and include the following documents:

- Two letters of recommendation, including a teacher’s recommendation.
- Parent letter addressing why they would like their child to attend MHT and their expectations.
- Work samples in Math and English from during the school year prior to the one they are seeking to enter in MHT.
- Two essays of at least 100 words each: “Why do you want to come to Maude H. Trefethen School?” and one other essay selected from the questions in the application letter.
- A copy of the student’s transcripts and academic records for the past two (2) years.
- Copies of all recent testing and assessments.

4. Admissions Committee meets to review all applications.

Once a completed application has been received from the student, the Admissions Committee will review the application and make a recommendation to the Superintendent, who shall make a decision on whether to accept the student into MHT.

5. Parents must sign and return the contract together with a deposit of \$1,000.

Program Information:

Tuition for the 2017-2018 school year is \$7,900. Tuition amounts are adjusted yearly based on school budget impacts. 50% of the tuition, less the deposit of \$1,000, must be paid by September 1st of each year, with the balance of the tuition paid in full by January 1st of the following year.

Parents must understand that the School does not have a duty to provide Free Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) to the Student, but only to deliver the services agreed upon according to the terms of this Agreement and to refrain from discriminating on the basis of disability. The School’s duty to provide special services to the Student pursuant to this Agreement shall end and revert back to the District of Residence in the event that the School concludes that it cannot appropriately serve the Student at MHT consistent with the decisions made by the IEP Team or Section 504 Team.
